

Read On Program 2016 July 4th – August 26th

Dear Teachers (Grade 1 - 5):

For 27 years, the *Read-On* program has helped students (**entering grades 2-6 in September 2016**) who are experiencing difficulty in reading to improve their reading skills. Read-On gives each student one-on-one practice in reading, language exercises and creative writing. This summer the library will continue to offer the numeracy stream, and hopes to have a French language tutor available in order to meet the needs of students in French Immersion.

The library will be offering tutoring at both the Main Library and St. Paul's Branch. Once registered, the child will attend *Read-On* for 45 minutes daily for 2 weeks. Our tutors are university students who have a special interest in literacy. All tutors have had considerable experience in working directly with children and receive intensive training before the program begins. However, this program is not designed, nor are the tutors qualified to teach children who have been classified with special needs.

The registration form is included with this letter. Registration fills very quickly and space is limited. Therefore, it would be greatly appreciated if you would hand out the registration forms immediately to any student you feel would benefit from this program.

New to the registration form is a Teacher Information Section. Please be sure to fill out and sign this section to help tutors evaluate the student and contact you with any questions or concerns they might have. Tutors create individualized programs for each student in the program. Your assistance will help each child be successful this summer. In order to better demonstrate to our funders the positive impact this program has on students we ask that you also complete the DRA indicator for each student.

Registration begins Saturday, June 4, 2016 from 9:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. at the Main Library, 173 Colborne Street. Parents must register in person. Registrations received by fax, email, letter or phone cannot be accepted.
